

Frequently Asked Questions

Eyelid Surgery (Blepharoplasty)

Dryness: After surgery you may notice your eyes feel dryer than normal. This usually subsides in a matter of days to weeks. Until then, use artificial tears to comfort and protect the eye surface.

Sensitivity and Vision: Your eyes may feel sensitive to light for several days, and your vision may blur for a week to 10 days. These are common occurrences and should not alarm you.

Numbness: Expect some numbness along the lash lines. A normal occurrence, this usually disappears within several weeks.

Scars: The scars will become almost invisible when they turn white. This usually happens 4-12 months after surgery.

Eyelids Sticking Together: Occasionally, the upper and lower eyelids will stick together the night of surgery. Use a moist Q-tip to open them gently.
